



Environmental Policy Statement

1. Statement of Intent

Sheaf Power Limited (WARDPOWER) is committed to achieving the highest possible level of Environmental performance as perceived by its Customers, Staff and Suppliers, in all its activities. Our Environmental Management System is designed to comply with the requirements of ISO14001:2015. Nevertheless, the Company is committed to the continual improvement of its Environmental performance and to reaching the highest standards in Environmental management: As a specialist engineering company we believe that our commitment to excellence and continual improvement represents our strongest path to the future and that both corporate and individual competence is the key to that objective.

In line with this commitment, we employ only suitably qualified persons. All employees undergo induction and continuous training and, to further compliment this, all personnel are encouraged and facilitated to undertake continuous professional development.

2. Implementation

Our commitment is facilitated by the use of a documented Operations Management System including an Organisational Structure, Responsibilities and Management Arrangements, Operational Procedures and Standards incorporating environmental arrangements and control measures. Collectively, these constitute our Environmental Management System and also deal with all our health, safety, environmental, quality and general operational requirements in order to ensure that all such areas are addressed with equal focus and minimum potential conflict.

This system, including this Policy Statement, is subject to periodic review (at least annually) and revision to ensure that it remains relevant and appropriate.

3. Organisation and Responsibilities

The Managing Director is ultimately responsible for all Environmental matters within the company. Managers and Supervisors have specific responsibilities in respect of their own departments & works, and these are designated in our Operations Management System.

In practice, responsibility for environmental performance rests not only with the Company but also with its Employees, Sub-contractors and Suppliers. The Company regards it as an obligation of all Employees not only to read this Policy Statement carefully, but to take an active interest in achieving the highest possible environmental performance.
